Presentations

Ted Forman held a hand-on demonstration of his new Cordless Milwaukee M12 Rivet Gun compared to a Hand Rivet Gun. The tool was much liked by all who tried it.



The M12 Rivet Gun can be purchased separately for around \$200. A complete kit – that includes a battery, charger, four different size retention nose pieces, and a bag – can be purchased for around \$350. It can pull up to 250 3/16" stainless steel rivets or 450 1/8" steel rivets on one charge with a 1.5ah battery, and reduces muscle effort from a hand tool by 60%. If you are thinking about building an all-aluminum aircraft – like a Sonex or RV, which would you choose to set around 10,000+ rivets?
