Editorial Notes by Larry Gordon

This last week I knocked a little dust out of my Hobbs meter by running numbers in the 1st two right hand cylinders of the meter. Two more similar flights and I will have added a little over an hour to my logged hours! It was a beautiful morning to go flying, but my priorities came first and the impending weather was to hold off until later in the day. Hopefully, I can accomplish my flight goal of becoming smarter today than I was yesterday, with some self-education in the basics of flying.

Surprising myself, I arrived at W23 and immediately started my pre-flight inspection. With seemingly time to spare, I pulled the upper cowling out of curiosity. Finding all in order, and knowing that I haven't been harboring any free-loading wildlife under the hood, I was soon pushing the Rans out of the hanger. The roar of the engine after the ignition sequence is always a welcomed sound! While warming up the engine prior to taxiing to Runway 27, I was

rehearsing my flight plans to familiarize myself with the sights, sounds, and most of all, the feel OF flying; not FOR flying. In my quest to increase my flying proficiency, I have been participating in EAA webinars, reading pertinent articles in Sport Aviation, and re-reading a classic, Stick and Rudder by Wolfgang Langewiesche. No gawking time today. Taxi to Runway 27; engine run-up; pre-takeoff checklist completion; traffic check; radio announcing flight intentions while positioning on runway; throttle to the **stops; and "Tally-ho"!**

With the power response of the engine and the lifting of the tail as the plane surges down the runway, the feeling I get is absolutely exhilarating! My autonomic response to the anticipated crosswind and quick instrument check brings me back to the cockpit of the Rans! The now visible horizon necessitates a call to the Wautoma AWOS, which confirms that the site picture of decreasing visibility was **"light rain", along with a**



dropping temperature. "Ah Tutter! Time for this one to come home!"

While determining how much time I actually had before the need to initiate my plan of action, a fellow Wild Rose pilot made a radio traffic call announcing his location and **being "inbound for landing"**. Radioing back to him with my location with same intention to land, he deferred to me as his being #2 to land. We both were on the ground, with my plane in the hangar before the rain started sounding on the roof. It was a shortened retraining flight, but satisfying to have taken. I think Steve Krog and Wolfgang Langewiesche would have approved of my flying.

In the last few newsletter articles I've written, you might have seen similar references to my lost flying proficiency, or an elaboration to a **basic principle of aviation. It's not like I have been having a recurring dream, but if the statistics are saying to you, "it**




