The Experimental Aircraft Association has awarded Tyler Pierson final installment of the Ray Aviation Scholarship for flight training. The final installment of \$2,000 for the scholarship has been wire transferred to your chapter's banking account. Per the agreement, these funds can be applied towards any flight training fees including CFI fees, aircraft rental fees, fuel, and flying club dues.

Please complete the final progress report upon the scholar's completion of flight training or twelve calendar months from the date the first installment of funds were received, whichever occurs first. Remaining funds, up to \$1,500 may be kept for future flying purposes such as earning additional endorsements, ratings, certificates, or exercising the privileges of the scholar's pilot certificate. Any funds remaining, in excess of the \$1,500 for future flying by the scholar, must be returned to EAA via check, unless the chapter has an additional scholar approved
