Candidates should be currently enrolled or accepted to a college, university, or trade school majoring in aviation related studies or in an approved flight school. Applicants applying for scholarships to assist with flying lessons only, must be twenty-five years of age or younger as of March 31, 2024 and have completed their first solo flight.
