John Licardi with his Cadet. It was a cold start for the day but the flying conditions were perfect.

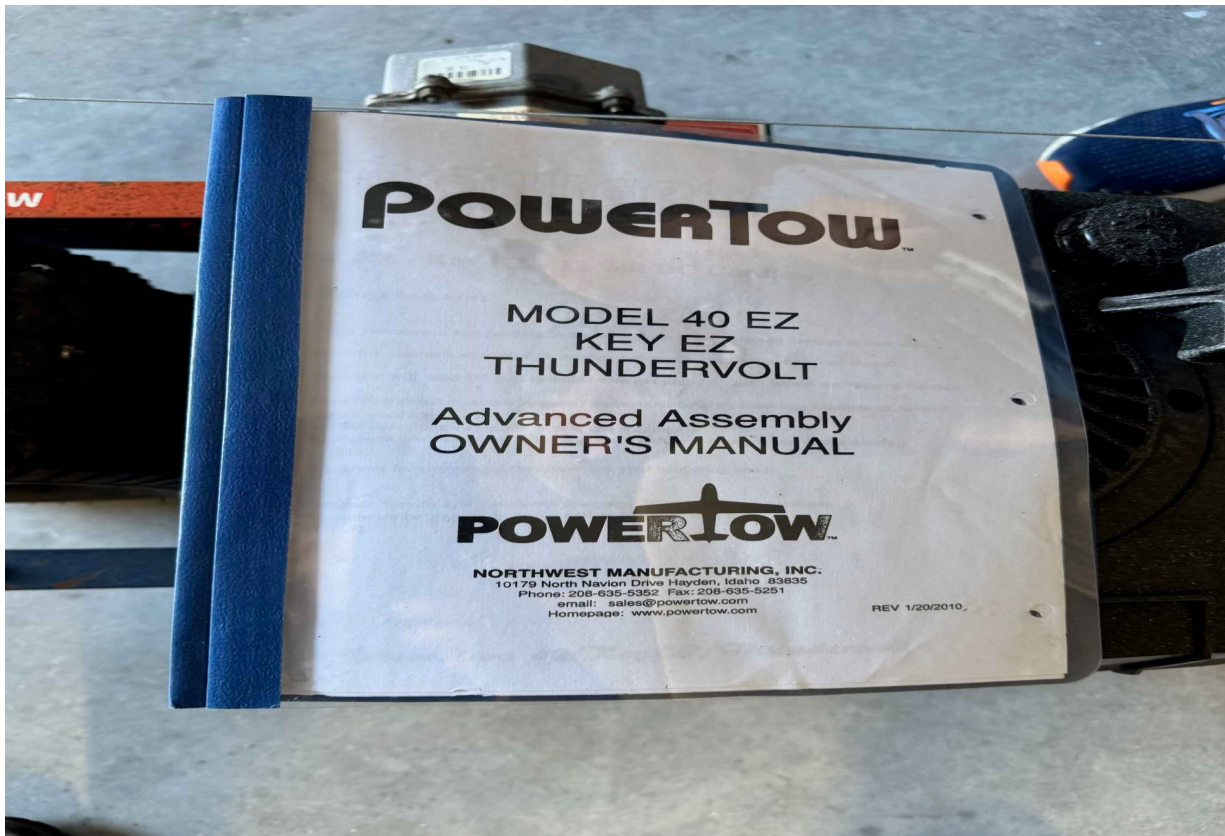
