Young Eagles March 29, 2025

Very good day for our YE rally. The day started off a bit windy with only 3 planes. But as the day progressed every thing came together with acceptable winds and 6 airplanes. We flew 39 YE's. Many thanks to all that helped doing registration, briefers, dispatch, escorts, & pilots. Good job!

We are working on having our hanger roof replaced and with the board approval we will move forward to get this project moving. We've picked a contractor to do the construction and have a loan pre approved with PNC Bank. In order to accomplish this renovation there are increases in rental pricing starting 6-1-2025. See page 3. The new rental rates for hanger and tie downs will take effect 6-1-25

These increases will help offset the cost of the hanger repairs. Once our contractor updates his estimate we will schedule the actual work. At this time we are working with \$71,875 total, 908 will put up \$25,000 and we'll get the bank loan for the balance \$46,875. Hanger occupants will be notified in advance of any construction to their individual hanger.

We have 2 aircraft in delicate conditions right now so we'll delay the start of construction until they are more mobile. Up date on the removing of our containers from the property as requested by the airport director. We have removed 3 so far with 2 more ready for pickup and 3 more to empty. There are two work benches available . This Saturday they will be offered. If there are no takers they will be offered to the public (road side).

But at times it takes a village to get things done, especially getting the wings in place.


